BayWa AG boosts its solar project business in the Netherlands

Munich, 15 March 2018 – BayWa AG will, subject to final approval from the relevant antitrust authorities, enter the solar project business in the Netherlands through BayWa r.e.'s acquisition of a 70 per cent shareholding in a project pipeline of around 2 gigawatts (GW) of solar plants from a consortium of GroenLeven Group, the country's leading solar project developer. Via a joint venture with BayWa r.e, the sellers will remain involved in the business, retaining 30 per cent of the pipeline.

"The Netherlands is an attractive and evolving market for the development of solar installations. The country has established and workable feed-in regulations, and renewable energy generation is yet to realise its full potential," explains BayWa AG Chief Executive Officer Klaus Josef Lutz. "Because the country has so far relied mainly on natural gas, renewable energy must now be significantly expanded to achieve the necessary CO₂ reductions. Tariffs have already been secured for around 800 MW of GroenLeven's pipeline, the biggest pipeline in Europe", explains Matthias Taft, Member of the Board of Management responsible for energy.
